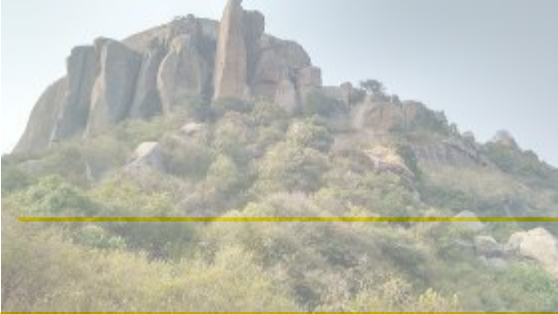

Overview



Introduction

- ▶ District carved out of the erstwhile Bangalore Rural district on 23 Aug 2007.
- ▶ Divided into 4 administrative divisions– Channapatna, Kanakapura, Ramanagara, Magadi
- ▶ Located approximately 50 km southwest of Bengaluru city
- ▶ Known for its silk production and has Asia's second largest cocoon market, after Devanahalli (Bengaluru Rural)
- ▶ Bidadi Industrial Area houses manufacturing units of Toyota, Coca Cola and a 1,400 MW combined gas-based cycle power plant
- ▶ Famous for the huge rocky outcroppings: Savandurga, Ramadevarabetta, SRS betta and Thenginkalbetta.
- ▶ Arkavathi, Kanva, Kaveri, and Shimsha rivers pass through the district

Earlier known as 'Closepet' after Sir Barry Close, a British officer, the district was renamed as Ramanagara by the former Chief Minister, Sri Kengal Hanumanthaiah. It is the birthplace of Sri Kempegowda, architect, builder and mentor of the present Bengaluru city. It is known for its power plants, silk and cocoon production, and was the first district to have modern office buildings like in Bengaluru city. Ramanagara is also famous for its huge rocks. The famous hindi movie SHOLAY was shot in and around these hills and hence the name SHOLAY HILLS.

Economy

- ▶ **GDP is INR 15,275 Crore** in the year 2014 -15 (at Current Prices)
- ▶ **Urbanisation in the district is 25%** compared to 39% in the state
- ▶ Ramanagara devotes **over 40% of its land for cultivation**
- ▶ **Agro and textile based industries along with wood/ wooden based furniture** form the major industries in the district,
- ▶ **Ragi, fruits and pulses** are the major crops that are grown here

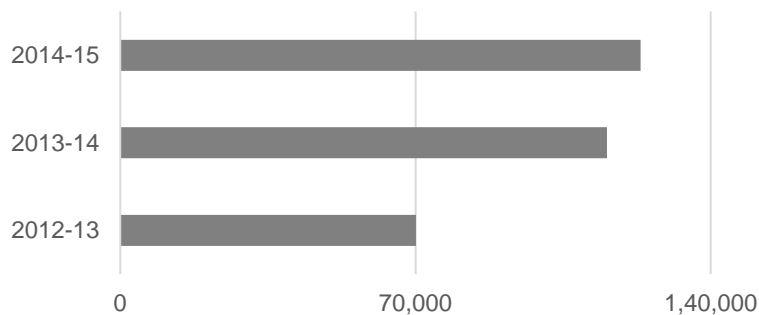

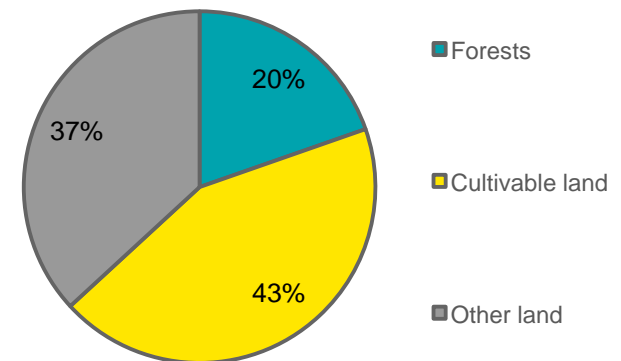
Key Economic Indicator

- Availability of medicinal plants at Savanadurga, Magadi administrative division

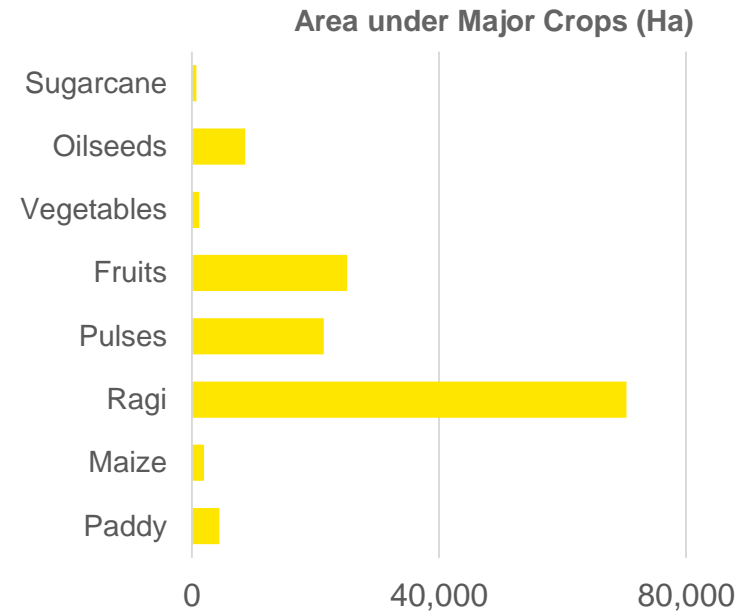
Thrust Areas

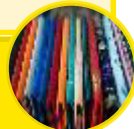


- GoK proposed an Integrated Textile Park. 125 acres of land at Harisandra has been identified

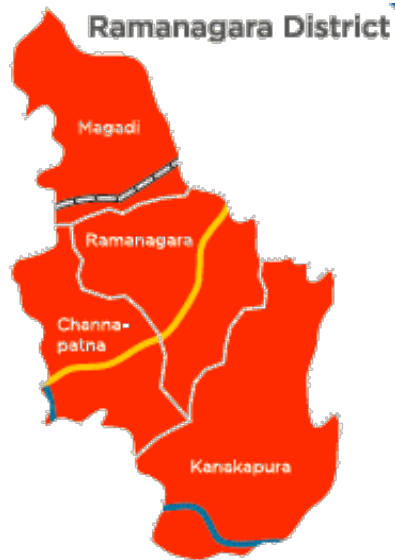

▶ Consumption: 5,405 units (industry), 1,089 units (domestic)

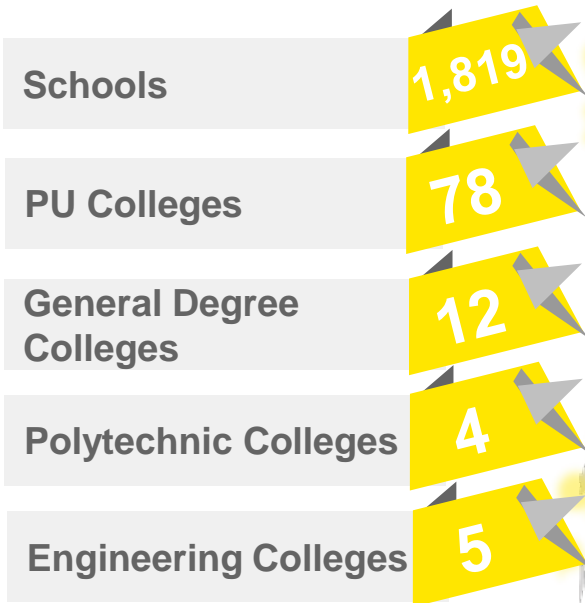

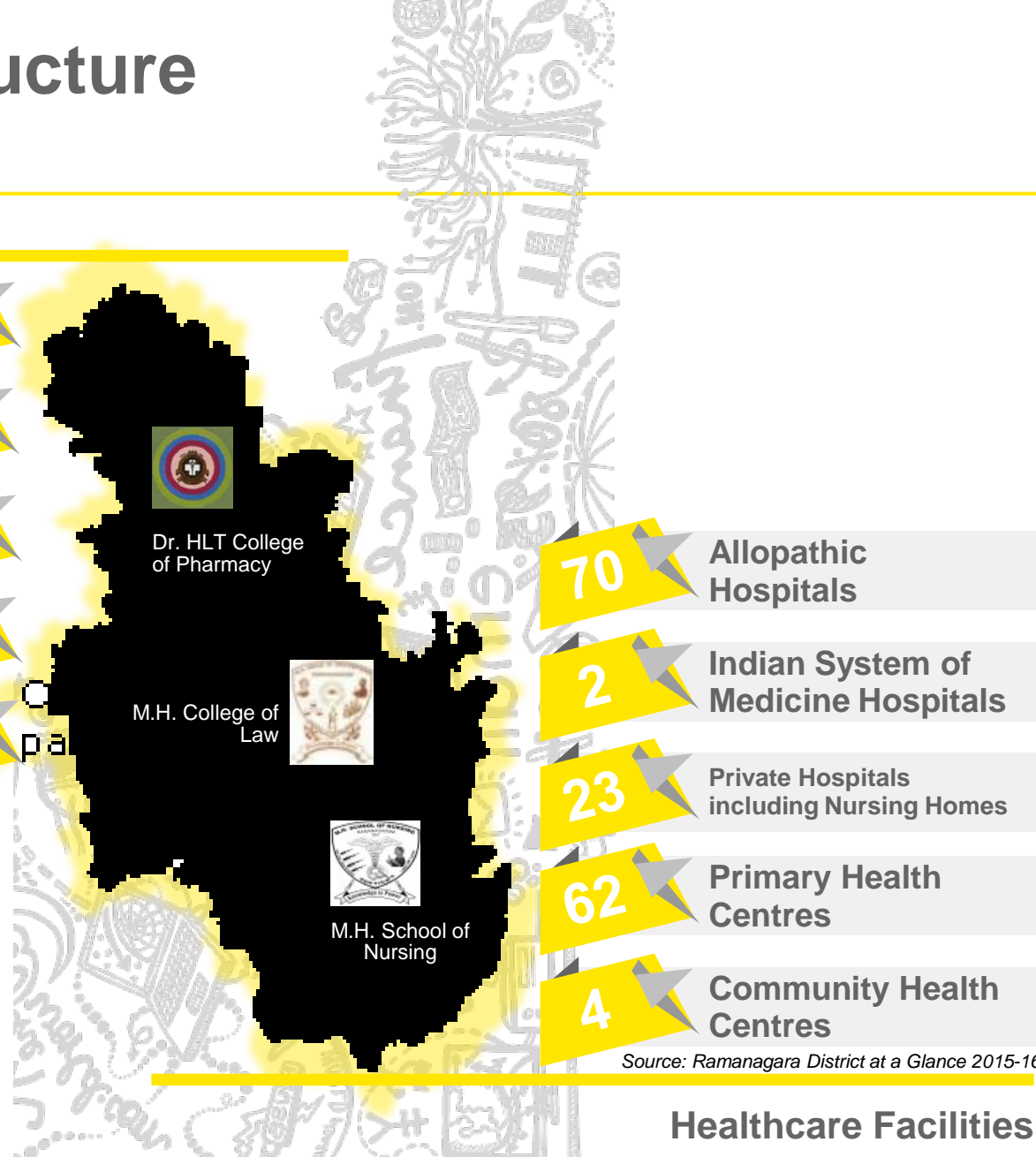

Artificial lake and tourist attraction located 69 kms away from Bengaluru



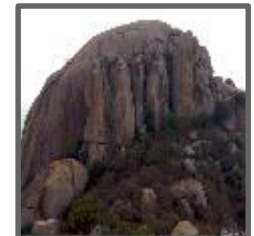
Revanasiddeshwara Betta

situated at 13 Km from Ramanagara and completely rocky hill with stunning natural beauty

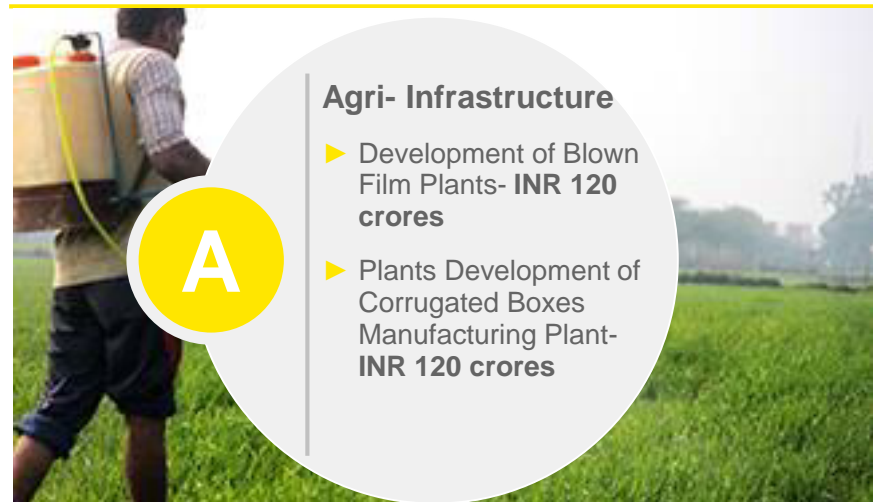


SRS Hills
