# STEEL

Contributed approx. 13.7 per cent of the total steel production in the country in FY 2017

Iron and steel industry in the state started with Mysore Iron Works (Visvesvaraya Iron and Steel Plant VISL) at Bhadravati in 1923



The combined steel production capacity of 18 units in the State at present is around 22 MMTPA



Ballari, Chitradurga, Koppal and Tumakuru are the nerve-centres of the iron ore deposits in the State



Houses two of the thirteen major steel plants in India

- VISL in Bhadravati
- JSW Steel in Hospet, Ballari

Estimated 2 billion metric tonnes of iron ore

Hosts country's 74 per cent magnetite and 11 per cent hematite resources



JSW Steel's plant at Vijayanagar, Ballari in Karnataka is the largest single location steel producing facility in the country with a capacity of 12 MTPA.

## CEMENT

- India is the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest cement producing country in the world.
- Karnataka produces more than 11 million tons of cement annually.
- It contributes to 6.51% of the total cement manufactured in India.
- The state occupies 7<sup>th</sup> position in the cement production of the country
- Has more than 16 cement industries.

The state has around 17,253 million tons of limestone deposits. Huge limestone deposits are present in the districts of Ballari, Kallburagi, Vijayapura, Shivamogga, Belgaum, Uttar Kannada, Chitradurga, and Tumakuru.

- Kalaburagi in Karnataka is one of the seven cement clusters located in the country.
- The cement plant of ACC at Wadi, Kalaburagi is among the largest plants..

Home to Dalmia cement plant, started its operation with 2.5 million tonne (MT) greenfield unit at Belgaum in Karnataka

International cement producing companies like Heidelberg from Germany, Vicat group from France and Lafarge from Switzerland have established their presence in the state.
